

TRES DIAS OF ST. LOUIS

Purpose of Tres Dias

Tres Dias is an adult weekend which claims to concentrate closely on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ. While Tres Dias explores the basic Christian beliefs, it is best described as a spiritual encounter with Christ. Many who have attended the weekend have experienced a deeper and more meaningful relationship with Christ as they sense His love in a dynamic way.

What happens on a Tres Dias weekend?

The Spanish words "Tres Dias" mean "Three Days". Tres Dias begins on a Thursday evening and ends the following Sunday evening. The team leading the weekend is composed of former attendees of a Tres Dias or similar weekend like Cursillo (ker-see-yo) who have volunteered their time for weeks of preparation by working and praying together as a unit. The basics of the Christian life and the meaning of living the Christian ideal are presented in Three Days. Tres Dias is centered around lay and clergy talks, each discussed by table groups. The basic atmosphere is one of love, joy, Christian fellowship, singing, laughing and worship.

Who should attend a Tres Dias weekend?

Tres Dias is designed for those who desire to be strengthened in their faith and to be brought closer to Christ in their discipleship. It is an ecumenical movement open to any Christians interested in deepening their walk with the Lord. All adults, age 21 and older, are welcome. There are weekends for men and weekends for women. If you are married, husbands are encouraged to attend first; wives usually attend a week or so later. Each attendee must be sponsored by someone who has previously attended a Tres Dias or Cursillo-type adult weekend.

The Fourth Day

One's life after attending a Tres Dias is called the "Fourth Day". Following Tres Dias a person is able to expand his or her own spiritual life and become a more active disciple of Christ in the world and in the church. Perseverance is enhanced through ongoing contact with the Tres Dias community and small reunion groups.

1. We believe and profess our faith in one Triune God - The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit (Matt. 28:19). 2.
