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WHY TRES DIAS?

The TresDias weekend is an opportunity for Christians to encounter Jesus Christ, experience other Christians serving them in love, and receive new inspiration for living our life in Christ. Tres Dias seeks the participation of all Christian denominations

- The main teaching of Tres Dias is God's unconditional love for us through His grace.
- The objective of Tres Dias is to strengthen His Church by a closer personal walk with Jesus
- The purpose of Tres Dias is to inspire apostolic action in our environment and Christian leaders in the church.



WHAT IS TRES DIAS?

TresDias is not a church, but a lay-led Christian movement designed to strengthen the local church by equipping believers for deeper faith and leadership. At its core is a three-day weekend experience—rooted in worship, prayer, fellowship, and community—that helps Christians grow in their personal relationship with Jesus Christ through a series of talks, discussions, and shared experiences.

Each spring and fall, TresDias hosts two back-to-back weekends—one exclusively for men, followed immediately by one exclusively for women. The men's weekend is held from Thursday evening through Sunday evening, and the following week, the women gather for their own weekend. The event takes place at Camp Mihaska in Bourbon, Missouri—a peaceful, wooded retreat center with beautiful surroundings that allow attendees to step away from everyday distractions and focus on their walk with Christ.

TresDias is open to Christians from all denominations and does not promote any specific doctrinal stance. Instead, our focus is on God's grace, the essentials of the Christian faith, and encouraging participants to return to their home churches better equipped to serve, lead, and love others in the name of Christ.

HOW TO ATTEND A TRES DIAS WEEKEND

Find a Sponsor - To attend TresDias, you'll need a sponsor—someone who has previously participated in a TresDias weekend. Walk to Emmaus, or Cursillo event, regardless of location. This sponsor will guide you through the process, provide encouragement, and answer your questions. Those thinking of attending for the first time are encouraged to spend time in prayer, seeking God's guidance about this important step in their spiritual journey. If you are married, we encourage the husband to attend first, followed by their wives, but this is not a requirement.

Complete an Application - Once you have a sponsor, they will provide you with the necessary application form and help you complete and submit it. Because spaces are limited and demand is high, attendance is granted in the order applications are received. Patience is appreciated as you wait for your opportunity to attend.
